### Employment, Investment, and Trade Linkages

#### Employment

European investment in California supported 337,400 jobs in 2004; 20% of the jobs were in manufacturing.

#### Investment

Of the \$90.6 billion invested in California in 2004, 50%, or \$45.1 billion came from Europe.

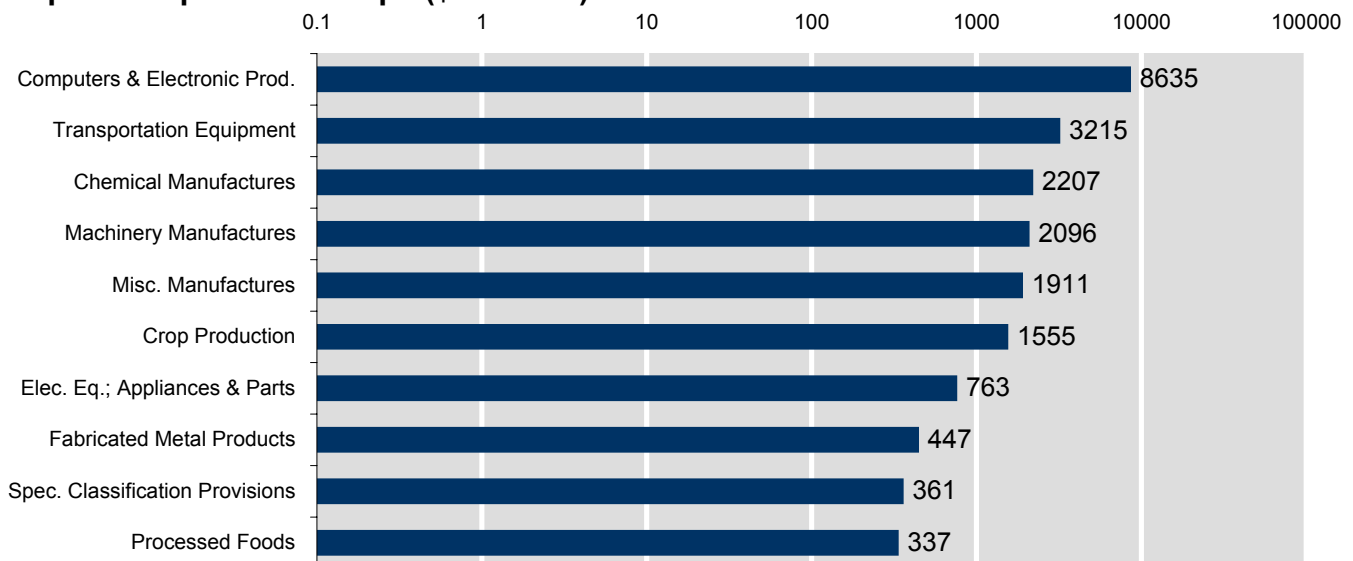

#### Trade

In 2005, Europe purchased \$23.2 billion worth of goods from California. More than a third of Californian exports to Europe consists of high-tech goods.
