Employment

European investment in Ohio supported 128,900 jobs in 2004; 40% of the jobs were in manufacturing.

Investment

Of the \$32.9 billion invested in Ohio in 2004, 56%, or \$18.5 billion came from Europe.

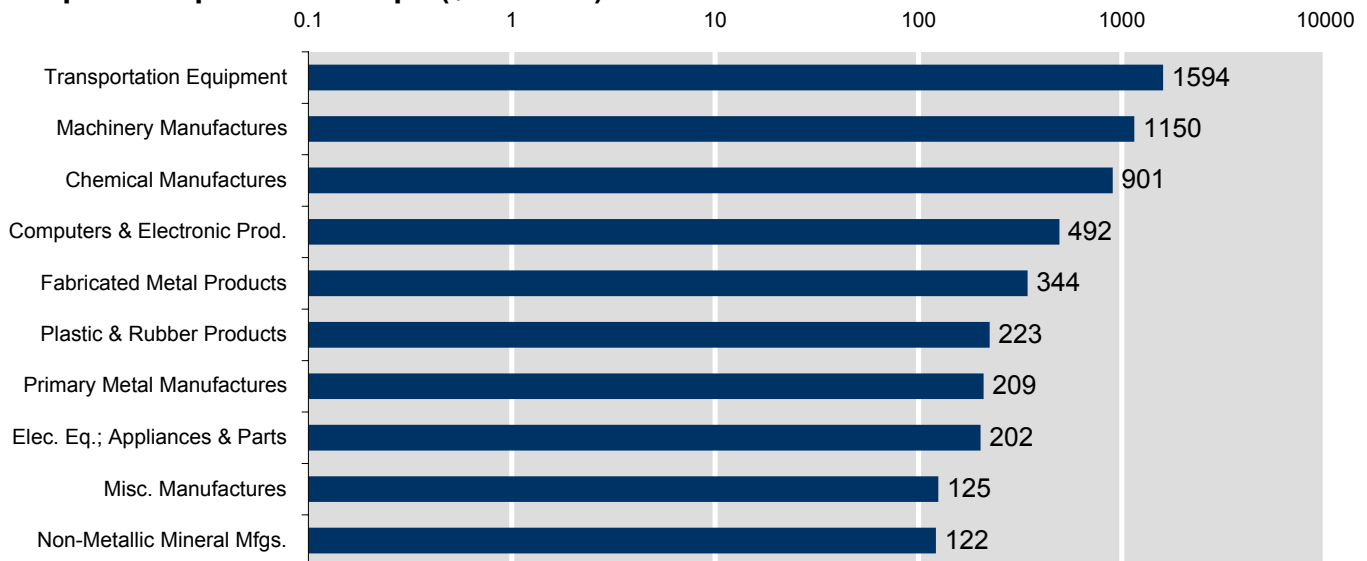
Trade

In 2005, Europe purchased \$5.7 billion worth of goods from Ohio.

Transportation equipment, machinery and chemicals are the state's top exports to Europe.
