

## Washington and Europe

### Employment, Investment, and Trade Linkages

#### Employment

European investment in Washington supported 48,800 jobs in 2004; 23% of the jobs were in manufacturing.

#### Investment

Of the \$17.5 billion invested in Washington in 2004, 52%, or \$9.1 billion came from Europe.

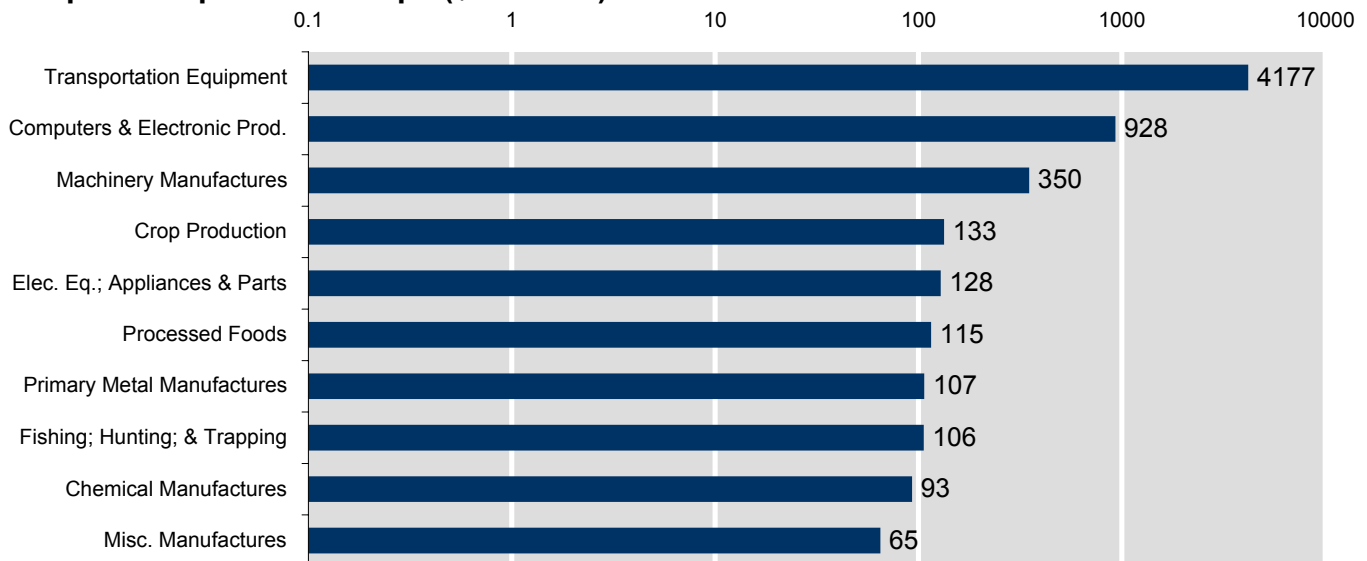

#### Trade

In 2005, Europe purchased \$6.4 billion worth of goods from Washington. Transportation equipment dominates exports to Europe.
